

UK STAYER WINS HONG KONG VASE

Red Cadeaux (Cadeaux Genereux) took out the Hong Kong Vase (Gr 1, 2400m) in a photo finish over Japan's Jaguar Mail (Jungle Pocket) with French-trained Meandre (Slickly) a further half length away third before a large crowd at Sha Tin yesterday.

The short head win providing some compensation for Red Cadeaux's incredibly close second to Dunaden (Nicobar) in last year's Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m), the race he finished eighth in this year.

MAGIC MILLIONS CUP HOPE TO SPELL

The White Hope (Bradbury's Luck), a winner of four of his five starts, will be spelled and miss the Magic Millions Cup (1400m) at the Gold Coast on 12 January to concentrate on the autumn and winter carnivals. Trainer Matthew Dunn said The White Hope was feeling the effects of his outstanding Eagle Farm win on 24 November when he ran a sizzling 1.21.57 for 1400m. "He hasn't fallen apart completely or anything like that but he's a little bit different to what he was going into his last few runs and I'd hate to take him to the races and have him race poorly," Dunn said.

"He deserved this win - three pixels in the Melbourne Cup last year, no pace in the Melbourne Cup this year and he got struck into in the Japan Cup and we should have finished sixth; he was the leading European horse there," said trainer Ed Dunlop after yesterday's victory.

"It's a fantastic day for everyone," he added.

"At the 200m mark I thought we were going to get beaten by Jaguar Mail but Gerald [Mosse] gave him a great ride and he was in the right place. The horse battled very hard today."

The Northern hemisphere bred six-year-old has had three Group One starts in three countries (Australia, Japan and Hong Kong) in just over a month, and his hard earned win was a truly international victory.

Red Cadeaux's win will go down as a British triumph, but his owner is the former Chairman of the Hong Kong Jockey Club Ronald Arculli and the jockey was leading French rider Gerald Mosse.

"Ronald Arculli deserves huge praise, and I'm so chuffed for him - to have a winner here is a huge deal," continued Dunlop.

"This is our third victory here and winning races like this is what it's all about for me. We've been lucky to have great owners and great horses to come here."

"To win three races, Ouija Board [2005 Vase], Snow Fairy (2010 Cup) and now Red Cadeaux - I'm pinching myself to think he's now won a Group One over a mile and half. He's come through the handicap system and he gets better and better - he's a really tough horse."

The victory took jockey Gerald Mosse to a record eight wins at the Hong Kong International Races stretching back to River Verdon's (Be My Native) success in the 1991 Invitational Cup (Gr 3, 1800m).

"Jaguar Mail made me make my move because I feared at the 500m that someone was coming up so I decided right away to pick up. From there he really fought to the line and showed fighting spirit all the way," said Mosse.

Jaguar Mail was having his fourth start in the Vase after finishing third (2008), and fourth (2009 and 2010) for trainer Noriyuki Hori.

The Andre Fabre-trained Meandre overcame a troubled passage in the stretch to claim third, a further half-length back.

Dunaden, ridden by Craig Williams, raced in about eighth spot before going wide from the 600m. He made good ground in the sprint home, without looking a threat, finishing fifth.

Red Cadeaux (6 ch g Cadeaux Genereux – Artisia by Peintre Celebre) has now raced 33 times for seven wins and 13 placings. He was purchased for 55,000gns at the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale Book 2.

By Cadeaux Genereux (Young Generation), Red Cadeaux is the only stakes winner out of the Peintre Celebre (Nureyev) mare Artisia who was placed at three. She is herself out of Almaaseh (Dancing Brave) who was the dam of 12 foals, 11 to race and eight winners including Almaty (Dancing Dissident), the Champion 3yo Sprinter in Ireland in 1996.

His third dam is Al Baharri (Blushing Groom), the Champion 3yo Filly & Miler in Ireland in 1985, winner of the Irish 1000 Guineas (Gr 1, 1m).



HONG KONG SPRINT GOES TO JAPAN'S LORD KANALOA

Japanese five-year-old Lord Kanaloa (King Kamehameha) raced away to an easy two and a half length win in yesterday's Hong Kong International Sprint (Gr 1, 1200m). Yesterday he was ridden by Yasunari Iwata who won the 2006 Melbourne Cup aboard Delta Blues (Dance In The Dark) and is trained by T Yasuda.

Lord Kanaloa was perfectly poised in fourth place to the turn and showed his class in adding his second Group One, having taken out Japan's premier sprint, the Sprinters Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at his previous start at Nakayama on 30 September.

A locally trained pair filled the placings with Cerise Cherry (Goldkeeper) finishing second and Captain Sweet (Fastnet Rock) third. Favourite, last year's Sprint winner Lucky Nine (Dubawi) was fifth while Australia's hope Sea Siren (Fastnet Rock) finished a disappointing ninth and Singapore's Super Easy (Darci Brahma) was tenth.

Neither the trainer John O'Shea nor jockey Jim Cassidy could explain Sea Siren's poor run, with the mare giving every indication she was fit and well going into the race.

"She's never run like that in her life," O'Shea said. "I've got no idea what happened."

Cassidy said he'd been unable to get a position in the first 300m, but it had not affected Sea Siren's chances at the end of the 1200m.

"She was three deep early, but it didn't matter. She only went to the corner," said Cassidy.

Japanese star Lord Kanaloa now boasts a record of 13 starts for eight wins and five placings. He is by the Kingmambo (Mr Prospector) stallion King Kamehameha and out of the Storm Cat (Storm Bird) mare Lady Blossom.

Lady Blossom was a winner of five races from 1000m to 1400m in Japan and she herself was the dam of five winners including Lord Balias (Brian's Time) who was a stakes placed winner of six races.

His second dam Saratoga Dew (Comorant) was the Joint top filly on the 1992 USA 3yo Free Handicap, winning eight races, from 6f to 9f including the Belmont Gazelle Handicap (Gr 1, 9f) and the Belmont Beldame Stakes (Gr 1, 9f).

HONG KONG MILE TO 'OF THE YEAR' AMBITIOUS DRAGON

The New Zealand-bred Ambitious Dragon (Pins), Hong Kong's two-time and reigning Horse of the Year, sprinted home brilliantly to win yesterday's Hong Kong Mile (Gr 1, 1600m).

He defeated the favourite Glorious Days (Hussonet) by three quarters length with outsider Packing OK (Redoute's Choice) a length and half away third in a fast 1:34.12.

He was ridden by Zac Purton who brought Ambitious Dragon down the outside to overhaul Glorious Days who beat him last month in the lead-up race – the Sha Tin Trophy (HK Gr 2, 1600m). "I travelled like a winner the whole way, but I did last time so I wasn't going to start counting my chickens until I got to the line," Purton said.

The Tony Millard trained-Ambitious Dragon was cleared by vets just hours before the race after he was found to be moderately lame in a hind leg on Saturday.

Millard has guided the Pins gelding from an initial Hong Kong rating of 52 up through the ranks to become the rated the best in the country.

Ambitious Dragon (6g Pins – Golden Gamble by Oregon) has now raced 23 times for 12 wins and five seconds. He was passed in for NZ\$47,500 with a reserve of NZ\$50,000 at the 2008 New Zealand Bloodstock Select Yearling Sale when offered by Belvedere Farm as Agent. The Hong Kong Jockey Club paid NZ\$420,000 for his High Chaparral (Saddler's Wells) half brother at the 2011 New Zealand Bloodstock Premier Yearling Sale and Bruce Perry Bloodstock paid NZ\$200,000 for his Thorn Park (Spinning World) half brother at this year's sale. A Mastercraftsman (Danehill Dancer) half brother is catalogued as **Lot 164** at next year's New Zealand Bloodstock Premier Yearling Sale.

He is out of the unraced Oregon (Halo) mare Golden Gamble whose two foals to race have both been winners. His second dam is the winner Gliding (Noble Bijou) who produced four winners including the stakes winning Recall (Kaapstad).

ALCOPOP THIRD IN CUP

The Australian-trained veteran Alcopop (Jeune) ran a gallant third in yesterday's Hong Kong International Cup (Gr 1, 2000m), coming from last on the home turn.

Last year's winner California Memory (Highes Honor) was a decisive winner over French-trained filly Giofra (Dansili) with Craig Williams bringing Alcopop, who was slowly away and came from near last along the rail to snatch third.

Eight-year-old Alcopop has been in career-best form this season, running second to Dunaden in the Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) before claiming the Mackinnon Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) on his last start on 3 November.

Trainer Jake Stephens said of Alcopop afterwards: "I can't believe how well everything's gone. He's been a perfect traveller, better than plenty of others from what I've seen. The thing about him is that he is a racehorse, he's got some ability and he uses it all."

HM The Queen-owned horse Carlton House (Street Cry) who will now join the Gai Waterhouse stable ran sixth in the 11 runner field.

The Tony Cruz-trained winner, California Memory (6 g Highest

Honor – Kalpita by Spinning World) has now won 11 of his 30 starts and was winning the Hong Kong Cup for the second time after scoring in last year's race by a length over the John Moore-trained Irish (Tertullian) who ran eighth in this year's race.

He is out of the winning Spinning World (Nureyev) mare Kalpita who has produced four winners, with California Memory being her only stakes performer. Kalpita is out of Kamania (Mr Prospector) who is a half sister to the Group winners Keos (Riverman) and a sister to the Group winning Prosknoa. His is the family of the Group One winning sires Act One (In The Wings) and Hector Protector (Woodman) as well as the top class filly Bosra Sham (Woodman).

NOEL CALLOW RETURNS WITH TREBLE

Jockey Noel Callow, who had not ridden in Australia since August, made a great return with a treble at Traralgon yesterday. Callow rode the Mick Price-trained debut runner Resemblance (Lonhro) to an easy win in the Maiden Plate (1100m), then won on Halfblood Prince (Skalato) in the Maiden Plate (1430m) and finished off with a victory aboard General Offer (General Nedym) in the Cargo Lounge Handicap (1100m). Callow won the recent International Jockeys' Weekend in Mauritius.

NZ DERBY WINNER RETURNS TO NZ

The 2010 New Zealand Derby (Gr 1, 2400m) winner Military Move (Volksraad) has returned to his original trainer Shaun Ritchie after

a disappointing stint in Hong Kong, where his trainers have included John Moore and Richard Gibson. Military Move, now a six-year-old, won two of his eight starts in New Zealand, including the Derby, before going to Hong Kong late in 2010. He had 19 starts there, winning twice.

In total Military Move has raced 27 times for four wins and \$1,969,030 in prize money. Ritchie indicated that he would spell the gelding before attempting a return to racing.

RUMYA TAKES GUINEAS

The Avontuur Estate Cape Fillies Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at Kenilworth on Saturday was won by the New Zealand-bred Rumya (3 f Red Ransom – Sayuri San by Fuji Kiseki). She is the only stakes winner out of the winning mare Sayuri San (Fuji Kiseki) and her third dam is the Champion Emancipation (Blethingly). Rumya won the Golden Slipper (Gr 1, 1400m) at Greyville last season.

AUS BREDS SCORE IN S.AFRICA

Royal Lance (3 c Tale Of The Cat – So Amorous by Generous) won the Desch Maiden Plate (1600m) and Comic Beauty (5 m Danzero - Golden Girl by Woodman) won a Fillies & Mares Handicap (1160m) at Turffontein on Saturday. Royal Lance was sold for \$32,000 to Royal Security from the draft of Newhaven Park as agent at the 2010 Magic Millions National Weanling Sale whilst Comic Beauty was sold for \$32,500 to Heritage Bloodstock at the 2009 Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale from the draft of Bellerive Stud as Agent.

FUN IN STARLIT

Pure Fun (2 f ex Chelsea Green by Key To The Mint) won Saturday's Starlet Stakes (Gr 1, 8.5f) at Hollywood Park by a length from Blonde Fog (Divine Park). Scarlet Strike (Smart Strike) was third. Saturday's victory was the first stakes win for Pure Fun who becomes the 43rd stakes winner for her sire Pure Prize (Storm Cat).

Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale - Glenlogan Stud

GLENLOGAN

How many horses are there in your draft this year and how does this compare to other years?

"We will have a draft of 23 in the 2013 sale – and that is usually around the number we would present each year."

Who are your stand out lots this year on both type and pedigree?

"The standout lot on pedigree is the Redoute's Choice filly out of She's A Meanie. The dam is a Group One winner and has already produced two stakes winners in She's Meaner and Love Conquers All."

"Whilst my two top picks on type would be the Denman colt of Harmony Hall and the Real Saga colt of the stakes winning mare Devil Inside. Both are exceptionally well-balanced individuals, have great frames and handle themselves superbly."

Which stallions do you think will sell well at this year's sale?

"All of the "tried and true" stallions will obviously be good sellers – sires like Fastnet Rock, More Than Ready, Redoute's Choice and co, but from the "newcomers" I would expect both Denman and Nicconi to find really good support from the buying bench. We have two Denman's in our draft and if they are typical of what the stallion is leaving then he will have a tremendous chance of making a real impact."

What sort of yearlings do you think sells well at this sale?

"Obviously the early-maturing type of youngster is very popular at these sales, however I do think that buyers are also becoming more discerning in regards to which vendors they target to buy from. History is a great indicator to the future and farms that keep producing good quality winners year in, year out have an established record that trainers can rely on."

What are your market expectations for the sale this year?

"Our yearlings have sold very consistently over the last few years at the Magic Millions – as buyers know our draft will sell at around the sale average – and I would think we would be in for a similar result in 2013. We will bring a really nice draft of athletic youngsters and we have a great record of selling quality horses. Hopefully that will be enough to generate plenty of interest."

Which restaurant would you recommend on the Gold Coast?

"My favourite restaurant on the Gold Coast is Moo Moo at Broadbeach."

OVERVIEW

Red Arrow (Red Ransom) began his career in Australia in the hands of Anthony Cummings before moving to the stable of John Sadler in America, where he enjoyed stakes success.

During the course of his time in Australia, Red Arrow won on his debut at Wyong over 1100m and finished second in the Sir John Monash Stakes (Listed, 1100m) and third Bletchingly Stakes (Gr 3, 1200m).

After those two stakes performances Red Arrow began his career Stateside, finishing third in a Hollywood Park Allowance race over six furlongs. He then went on to win three consecutive starts at Santa Anita over six and six and a half furlongs in late 2008 and early 2009.

Red Arrow then returned to stakes company with a fourth in the Fields Sprint Stakes (Listed, 6f) at Golden Gate before winning the Los Angeles Handicap (Gr 3, 6f) at Hollywood Park to Paul's Hope (Lake Austin).

Red Arrow retired the winner of four of his 17 starts.

By Sire Of Sires Red Ransom (Roberto), Red Arrow's dam, Lady Jakeo, is by Champion Australian Sire Last Tycoon (Try My Best), and herself won two Group One races, the Australia Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) and Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m). She also foaled the Hong Kong Group Three winner Able Choice (Dehere), Momentum (Kenmare), who was second in the Hong Kong Derby (HK Gr 1, 2000m) and the juvenile winner Miss Jakeo (Unbridled's Song), the dam of the Miss Judgement (Strategic) and Fifth Avenue Lady (Encosta De Lago), who both won Group Threes, and Miss Onassis (General Nediym), the winner of two Listed races.


